From time to time parents disagree with the identification or placement of their child. In order to appeal either the identification or placement of a child, a specific process has been developed. This process is outlined below. Please note that the request must be received in writing and that timelines need to be followed.

What can a parent/guardian do if they disagree with the IPRC decision?

If you do not agree either the identification or placement decision made by the IPRC, you may, within 15 days of receipt of the decision, request that the IPRC hold a second meeting to discuss your concerns; or within 30 days of receipt of the decision, file a notice of appeal with the Superior-
